

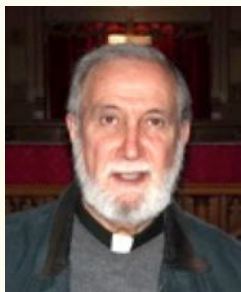

Over 8 years ago Fr. Stanley served for 16 months as priest-in-charge of St. Joseph's Church in Punta Gorda, Belize. As he did in 2010, Fr. Stanley has accepted the invitation of a mission group from Christ Church Cathedral, Fredericton, to join them in Belize for the first week of March. The group will be supporting the Anglican Parish of San Ignacio, and one of its schools, St. Hilda's. While his own expenses are fully covered, Fr. Stanley is hoping to take a monetary gift from fellow Christians here in Ontario. Contributions toward such a gift can be made through the Church office.



Christmas Outreach

The St. John's Church Outreach Committee helped to treat numerous families to food and gifts. On December 18th volunteers took lists of food to feed adults and children to the Davis Independent store, where they filled shopping baskets. Food was transferred to numbered boxes to match the lists to ensure each family received the goods they required. Matching the food boxes, were bags of presents donated by the parishioners of St. John's. The following day, the food and gifts were taken to the Salvation Army in Cobourg to be distributed to families in Northumberland County.
