Treasure Trove will hopefully reopen March 15th (weather permitting) and donations will be collected starting the first week of March. Donations of clothing can be brought to St. John's or deposited at the Treasure Trove's Blue Boxes, located at Happy's PetroCan on Toronto Road and at The Bargain Shop's parking lot on Mill Street South. Last year, the Treasure Trove raised over \$45,000 and donated over 115,000 pounds of clothing to the Diabetes Clothesline program.

Clothing sells for \$2 per adult item and \$1 per children's items. Hours are Wed. 6-8pm and Fri. & Sat. 9am-noon.
