The Christmas Story originally was an Epiphany Cantata presented in January. Over the years it was moved to December and evolved to its current state with the encouragement of Canon Nainby. The Story was originally directed by Mrs. Pearl Finnie. It was passed on to Mrs. Georgiana Holton in 1968 who carried the torch until 5 years ago, and since then, Kathy Mason, Georgiana's daughter, has brought the people of Port Hope this beautiful production of our Savior's birth.

The Christmas story, in its completed form, is the result of the hard work of countless volunteers including cast, choir, make up, lighting, staging, costuming, back stage and other miscellaneous help. Many of the volunteers are from St. John's, but others come from the community. The casting call will be for Oct. 27 and the first rehearsal will be Nov. 10 (time to be announced).
